Ivor Jones Memorial Concert, Friday 20th April, 7.30pm

Revd. Dr. Ivor Jones was best known to us at Castle Street as the Principal of Wesley House, a post he held for fifteen years until 1999, while he was also one of the compilers of the Methodist hymnbook *Hymns and Psalms*. He died in April 2016, and, two days short of two years on from his funeral, Wesley Methodist Church is hosting a concert in his memory.

The concert will feature Alison Nicholls on harp and Geoff Batty on organ. Tickets cost £12 (£6 for concessions), and can be obtained from Wesley Church (tel.: 352 115) or Wesley House (tel.: 765 832).
